# **Minutes of 2024 AMPC Congress**

## **1. Opening & welcome message by AMPC President, Mr. Hyunjun KIM**

Mr. Hyunjun KIM, the President of AMPC, warmly welcomed all delegates from member federations in Asia participating in the Congress.

He expressed gratitude towards Dr. Klaus Schormann, the President of the UIPM, for his ongoing support to the AMPC. He also thanked the member federations for their commitment and dedication.

President KIM emphasized the significance of the 2024 congress, noting that it included crucial elections for leadership over the next four years. He expressed his hope that the congress would be productive and the elections would bring in leaders committed to the future of Modern Pentathlon in Asia.

He concluded with special thanks to the Korea Modern Pentathlon Federation, led by President Mr. Hanjoon LEE, for their extensive support in hosting the successful 2024 Asian Championships and 2024 AMPC Congress in Korea.

## **2. Welcome message from UIPM President Dr Klaus Schormann**

Dr. Klaus Schormann, the President of UIPM, warmly welcomed all delegates from the Asian member federations. He expressed his deep gratitude to the dedicated delegates who play an active role in the development of Modern Pentathlon.

Dr. Schormann mentioned about the preparations for the upcoming Olympic Games in Paris 2024 and Los Angeles 2028, emphasizing the importance of unity and collaboration.

He urged all member federations to work together under the guidance of the Asian Confederation to move forward effectively.

## **3. Roll Call**

21 nations attended, so that President Kim officially opened the 2024 AMPC Congress with 21 members.

#### **4. Election of three(3) tellers of votes and two(2) scrutineers**

President Kim proposed following 3 tellers of votes and 2 scrutineers who are responsible for checking and counting the ballot papers at the voting.

  - Hanna Ji from Korea

#### **5. Approval of the minutes of 2023 AMPC Congress**

President Kim reported on the minutes of 2023 AMPC congress, and there was no remark. The minutes of 2023 AMPC Congress was approved.

#### **6. Joint report of the President and Secretary General**

**(President)**

A written report was already circulated to all members, before the congress and President Kim briefed as below;

#### **7. Report of Executive Board Members – Vice Presidents**

Written reports were already circulated to all members, before the congress and Vice President, Cassandra Choh & Varlerii Novikov briefed at the meeting.

There was no remark.

## **8. Approval of the budget for 2024/2025**

The budget plan for 2024 with details was already circulated to all members, before the congress. SG Yeo briefed the report, incomings & outgoings for 2024. He also explained that the next Executive Board to be elected will be responsible for 2025 budget, but assured that the amount from the UIPM and AMPC sponsor will be the same, as this year.

President Kim confirmed that 2024 budget plan is approved and also confirmed that next Executive Board elected will be responsible for 2025 budget.

There was no remark.

## **9. Decision on motion submitted by UAE**

President Kim put forward the motion to the congress and UAE explained the objective of the motion, background and details as below;

- Motion: Establish the Women's Commission in the AMPC
- Objective: Forming a Women's Commission is crucial for promotion gender equality empowering women, and creating an environment that values diversity and inclusion.

UIPM President gave a remark about the already existing Women's Commission at the UIPM where Mrs Choh is also the Chair.

SG Yeo confirmed 21 possible votes, and 14, as 2/3 majority, before the voting. Then President Kim proceeded the voting and the results were as below;

- **Yes: 18 / No: 1 / Abstention: 2**

Accordingly, President Kim confirmed that the motion was passed and the headquarter will prepare detailed articles, according to the UIPM regulations.

## **10. AMPC Elections**

SG Yeo explained the procedures and regulations about the elections to be seen by 3 tellers of votes and 2 scrutineers.

- A successful candidate must have an absolute majority which is one more than a half in the first and second round to be elected.
- And the candidate with least votes will be eliminated and not go to the next round.
- Finally, candidate with a simple majority, who has more votes than others will be elected at the third round.

Before the elections, each candidate had an opportunity to make a presentation and introduce themselves to the congress for the election, up to 3 minutes.

Both of them will represent Asia on the UIPM coaches and athletes committee respectively, and work for the interest of Asian athletes and coaches.

**The term of office for all the above elected AMPC officials will begin, after the 2024 UIPM Congress in November this year.**


